NOTICE INVITING TENDER NO. HWB/CIVIL/TAL/09/07

Sealed lump sum rate tenders in two Parts viz. Part A (Technical bid) and Part B (Financial & Commercial Bid) are invited on behalf of President of India by the Additional Chief Engineer (Civil), Heavy Water Board from approved and eligible contractors up to 1500 hrs on 26/02/2010 for the following work at HWP (Talcher) Housing colony at Vikrampur. The eligibility of prospective bidders for the purpose of issue of Tender document will be decided through valid registration in appropriate class with CPWD, State PWD, MES, Railways, DAE, BARC etc. and / or having experience of executing similar work and production of Certificates regarding successful completion of at least one similar work costing not less than Rs.108 lakh or two similar works costing not less than Rs.81 lakh or three similar works costing not less than Rs.54 lakh each, during the last five years. The value of executed works shall be brought to the current costing level by enhancing the actual value of work at a simple rate of 7% per annum calculated from the date of completion to the last date of receipt of application for tender. The bidders not having experience of executing similar work will not be issued tender documents. Similar work means design, supply, setting up of Sewage Treatment Plant of capacity not less than 300 m³/day and providing & laying sewage pipe lines etc. In addition, the following may also be produced at the time of purchase of Tender Document (i) Bank Solvency Certificate for Rs.54 lakh (ii) Latest Income Tax Clearance certificate or audited statement of account of last three years (iii) Average Annual turnover for last three consecutive years for Rs.67 lakh not having incurred any loss in more than two years during last five years ending 31/03/2009.

Bids also can be submitted by post but the prospective bidders are advised to take into account the time required for postal transit.
